AIMS

This one-day simulation course aims to train gynaecology and radiology trainees in the skills required for effective and sensitive transvaginal ultrasound scanning through use of a state of the art scanning simulator. The focus of the course is to provide the trainees with the necessary knowledge and skills to perform this intimate examination.

OBJECTIVES

To provide trainees with knowledge and skills to:

- Obtain the maximum information during the procedure by optimising the image quality through effective use of the imaging equipment
- Obtain informed consent and perform the ultrasound sensitively
- To describe and perform a standard protocol for transvaginal scan
- Identify normal pelvic anatomy as seen with a transvaginal scan
- To demonstrate some of the basic pathology encountered on routine transvaginal scan
- To enable trainees to practice transvaginal ultrasound identification and measurement of first trimester pregnancy.

This course is intended for gynaecology and radiology trainees requiring the skills to perform Transvaginal Ultrasound.
